NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

WHO: Project Proponent, Sonoma County Public Infrastructure

WHAT: Todd Road and Standish Avenue Intersection Improvements Project: The proposed project

would upgrade the intersection at Todd Road and Standish Avenue with the installation of a traffic signal, storm drain inlets, curb-return sidewalk improvements, and bicycle lanes and signage provided on both sides of Todd Road within the project limits. The project would be constructed primarily within existing Sonoma County transportation right-of-way but would require partial property acquisition from one property to bring the northwest curb into roadway compliance totaling less than one-tenth of an acre. The project site is not identified on any of the California Department of Toxic Substances Control's list enumerated under Government Code Section 65962.5

In accordance with Public Resource Code and CEQA Guidelines, the County of Sonoma provides notice to agencies and interested parties that it is releasing a final Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the project. The IS/MND did not find potential environmental impacts that could not be mitigated to a less-than-significant level.
